New Member Orientation

- Instructor-led classroom training
- Five hour session scheduled and held in the regional area within the first two months of appointment
- Content: Importance of Early Childhood Development, Building an Early Childhood System, First Things First Organization, Regional Life Cycle, Strategic Planning Framework, Effective Regional Council Membership

Core Topics

- Virtual instructor led training via WebEx
- 1.5 to 2 hour sessions scheduled throughout the first 12 24 months of appointment
- Critical topics for all new members: Open Meeting Law, Conflict of Interest, Statewide Strategies, Public Affairs/Communications & Engagement, and Evaluation

On the Job Training

- Individual meetings with the Regional Director
- Frequency, duration and length varies and can occur from the first month of appointment
- Complete initial intake paperwork and required State trainings
- Region-specific topics: role of the Regional Director and other staff, council dynamics, regional needs and assets, current strategic plan and funding plan
